# **Draw Like Me Activity**

Materials: Drawings, blank paper, and parkers

#### Focus Area: Communication

#### Time Needed

• 15-20 minutes

#### Group Size:

• 10-80 people (even numbers so you can pair them up)

### Directions

- Have people divide in pairs
- Provide 1 person with a blank piece a paper
- Provide 1 person with drawing (do not show drawing to others)
- The person with the drawing will describe to the person what their drawing looks like without using the
- The person with the blank piece of paper will try to draw what their partner is telling them

## **Debriefing Questions**

- What made this activity challenging?
- As the person with the drawing, how did you describe to your partner what to draw without actually saying what the picture was?
- As the person drawing, in what ways did your partner communicate effectively with you?
- What did you learn from this activity that you can use in your organizations or when working in a team/group setting?
